Please note that certain gaming events, such as raffles or bingo, requires registration and licensing with the state. Be sure to check ALL local and state laws before moving forward.

HOW WE CAN HELP

FOR ALL APPROVED FUNDRAISERS, THE MDS FOUNDATION CAN:

- Offer advice on event planning and fundraising
- Provide access to your own personal fundraising campaign through MobileCause with a 'Text to Donate' number
- Provide you with our logo for your marketing materials
- Provide you with a template marketing flyer
- Provide the MDS Foundation printed literature for distribution at your event
- Promote your fundraiser

WE RELY ON YOU TO PLAN AND COORDINATE ALL DETAILS OF THE FUNDRAISER, INCLUDING:

- Create your own mailing list of donors, vendors, and sponsors
- · Planning the agenda and securing the location
- Deduct any anticipated costs from the funds raised prior to sending your final gift to the MDS Foundation
- · Solicit businesses and vendors to support your event
- Promoting the fundraiser
- Printing promotional materials for the event
- Insurance, permits, and liability coverage related to the fundraiser
- Working and managing the actual fundraiser or event

THE MDS FOUNDATION IS UNABLE TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:

- MDS Foundation tax exempt certificate
- Insurance or liability coverage
- Funding or reimbursement for your expenses
- Guaranteed attendance of the MDS Foundation staff

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS A THIRD PARTY EVENT FUNDRAISER?

• A third party event fundraiser (TPE fundraiser) is an event organized and managed by a volunteer in which funds are raised in support of the MDS Foundation.

WHAT ARE SOME EXAMPLES OF TPE FUNDRAISERS?

• Past volunteer fundraisers have included golf tournaments, ATV wheeler ride and mud run, benefit concerts, modeling/photography events, and marathons. Funds can be raised through participant fees, ticket sales, auctions, and more.

WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOR HOSTING A TPE FUNDRAISER?

• The process is made easy for you. Fill out a quick application with your event details to ensure compliance with our policies and procedures. These policies serve to ensure that all events using the MDS Foundation's name and logos maintain a prudent cost of funds raised; follow all relevant local, state, and federal laws; and portray the MDS Foundation in a positive light. Upon submission, a member of our staff will get back to you within two business days to follow up with any additional questions or let you know that your event is approved.

CAN I USE THE MDS FOUNDATION'S NAME AND LOGO WHEN PROMOTING MY FUNDRAISER?

Once you have submitted the quick application and your fundraiser is approved, we will provide
you with the logos for your marketing materials. Anyone using the MDS Foundation logos must
have the logo use approved by the MDS Foundation liaison. For example, if you put our logo on
your website, you would need to forward the link to your event liaison, and they would take a
quick look and approve it.

WILL THE MDS FOUNDATION STAFF BE ABLE TO HELP ME ORGANIZE MY FUNDRAISER?

The MDS Foundation team is eager to provide guidance and strategy for your fundraiser. We
also recommend you form a committee, who can support you during the planning period and
throughout the entire event.

WILL AN MDS FOUNDATION REPRESENTATIVE ATTEND THE FUNDRAISER?

• We will do our best to support you and your event in any way we can.







HOST A SATELLITE MOVE FOR MDS WALK!







In 2021, we held five **Move For MDS** walks that took place in the Pacific Northwest, California, Chicago, New York City, and Boston/Global and we're thrilled to share that we have raised over \$565,000 to accelerate critical research of Myelodysplastic Syndromes.

Our Boston/Global walk takes place the Sunday closest to MDS World Awareness Day and there's no better way to honor the day than being involved in our international event. The event is virtual & live streamed so you can tune in from anywhere in the world!

Can't make it to one of our **Move for MDS** City locations? Consider hosting a satellite **Move for MDS** walk held in conjunction with one of our walks. We encourage virtual participants from all around the world to assemble as a community and walk close to home. We have had teams participate from the United States, Europe, Asia, & Australia.
